INSTRUCTIONAL SWIM PROGRAM POLICIES

Parents without children are welcome to watch swim lessons from the viewing area or on the pool deck. (Please note that the bleachers are reserved for swimmers only.) Parents with children are **NOT ALLOWED** to watch swim lessons from the pool deck and must proceed to the viewing area. **NO STROLLERS ON THE POOL DECK PLEASE.**

Swimmers registered for instructional swim classes are only permitted in the pool during the scheduled class time. Swimmers should remain seated until the start of class.

Group Lessons will only run if a minimum of 3 children are enrolled in the class. (There must be a minimum of 5 children for the Shrimp/Inia & Perch classes.) If a class is cancelled due to low enrollment, a refund for the full amount will be issued.

One make-up swim lesson is permitted within the 9-week session. Please call the Aquatics department to schedule the make-up swim class. (There are NO make-ups available for the Teen Lessons Class.)

Once a child is registered for a class, a \$25 fee will be charged for any request to change or withdraw the child from their current class. A Wyckoff YMCA credit will be given for all requests to withdraw from a class.

All children with chin length hair or longer must wear a swim cap. Swim caps are available at the front desk for \$5.00 each. All children not toilet-trained must wear a swim diaper & vinyl pants with a bathing suit in the pool. The vinyl pants are available at the front desk for \$3.00 each.

NO CHILD IS PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE POOL AREA WITHOUT AN ADULT. We ask that all adults come onto the pool deck to pick up their children at the end of their class.

LOCKER ROOM POLICIES: No parents are allowed in the Boys & Girls locker rooms Monday through Friday from 3:30-6:00pm as there are many boys & girls using the locker room facilities during these hours. If you need to assist your child in the locker room during these times, please use the Family locker room or the Family/Handicapped locker room (located off of the Boye Pool deck). Parents with children of the opposite sex should always use a Family Locker room to change the child.

We reserve the right to substitute an instructor due to unforeseen emergencies or illness. All instructors on our staff are well qualified to teach all of our swim classes. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
